Ancestors of Capt. Simeon SAMPSON

First Generation

1. **Capt. Simeon SAMPSON**,^{1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7} son of **Peleg SAMPSON** and **Mary RING**, was born in Aug 1736 in Kingston, Plymouth Co., MA,^{1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 7} died on 22 Jun 1789 in Plympton, Plymouth Co., MA^{1, 2, 7, 8} at age 52, and was buried in #50, Section C-East, Burial Hill, Plymouth, MA.¹

- Revolutionary War: 1776-1781.^{3, 8, 9, 10, 11} "One of the most distinguished naval commanders of the revolution."
"The ship was called the 'Mercury,' and, commanded by Capt. Simeon Sampson. was employed to carry public despatches to our minister in France."
"...the Brig Hazard. She was built in Boston, of peculiar model, and carried sixteen guns. She made three successful cruises - one from October 1777, to May 1778, under the command of Simeon Sampson ..."
Commander of ship "Mars."
- Will written: 14 Mar 1787.^{2, 3, 8} Proved 3 Aug 1789. Names wife Deborah, daughters Lydia Cushing Goodwin, Deborah, Marcy, and Marie Samson; son George Washington Samson. Wife Deborah executrix.
- Age at Death:^{2, 8} 53.
- Gravestone:¹ Pyramidal slate, encased in rough hewn granite. Very large urn with a palm bending over it from the right side. (Robinson #50)
Blue slate 3 1/2 feet high. Face of stone carved to represent large urn shaded by a willow. On urn is the inscription, the base containing the epitaph. (Drew No. 1114) Epitaph reads:
"O ye whose cheek the tear of pity stained
Draw near with pious reverence & attend
Here lie the loving Husbands dear remains
The tender Father & the Generous Friend
The dauntless heart yet touched at human woe
A Friend to man to vice alone a foe."

- Deborah SAMPSON** was born on 25 Apr 1768 in Plymouth, MA^{2, 13, 18} and died on 19 Dec 1833 in Homer, Cortland Co., NY^{13, 15, 18} at age 65.
- Unidentified son SAMPSON** was born on 15 Sep 1770 in Plymouth, Plymouth Co., MA,^{2, 12, 13, 19} died on 15 Sep 1770 in Plymouth, Plymouth Co., MA,^{2, 12, 13, 19} and was buried in #49 Section C-East, Burial Hill, Plymouth, MA.¹²
- Isaac SAMPSON** was born on 16 Oct 1771 in Plymouth, Plymouth Co., MA,^{2, 13, 20, 21} died on 29 Nov 1782 in Plymouth, Plymouth Co., MA,^{2, 13, 20, 21} at age 11, and was buried in #58 & #63 Section C-East, Burial Hill, Plymouth, MA.²⁰
- Mary/Mercy SAMPSON** was born on 3 Jun 1775 in Plymouth, Plymouth Co., MA,^{2, 12, 13, 22} died on 1 Oct 1777 in Plymouth, Plymouth Co., MA,^{2, 12, 13, 22} at age 2, and was buried in #49 Section C-East, Burial Hill, Plymouth, MA.¹²

- xii. **Maria A. SAMPSON** was born 4 Jan 1784 or 27 Jun 1784 in Plympton, Plymouth Co., MA,^{2, 13, 29} died on 25 Feb 1860 in Bufort, Monroe Co., NY^{13, 25, 29} at age 76, and was buried in Penfield, Monroe Co., NY.²⁵

- Two wives?:⁹⁷ Clarence Almon Torrey, PhD, and Robert S. Wakefield, F.A.S.G., make the strong case for Abraham Sampson having two wives: the first being an unidentified daughter of his Duxbury neighbor Lt. Nash and the second being completely unidentified.

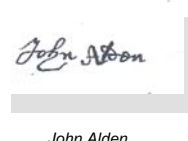
